Proactive Prevention

- Temperature checks for everyone entering the school building each day (teachers, staff, students). Student temps will be taken before they exit their vehicle.
- Visitors must schedule appointments prior to coming to the school & should call ahead before entering the building.
- Students who get sick at school will stay in a designated "sick room" until they are picked up. Upon exit, that room will be sanitized.
- Masks are required when students are traveling. Masks will be required in Chapel.
- Lunches will be eaten in the classroom for the month of August. Lunchboxes only M-TH, pizza option Friday. Microwaves will not be available to students.
- Touchless sanitation stations will be located throughout the school & students will be encouraged to use them frequently.
- High touch areas will be sanitized twice daily during the school day.
- The school day will be extended 15
 minutes to add 6 additional stockpile days to
 the school calendar, making a total of 20.
 (The extended school day applies to Jr.K,
 Stay & Play, K-12. PreK will still have a 12pm
 dismissal time.)
