Re: COVID-19 Update

Dear Parents & TCA Family,

The Tipton Christian Academy school board and program directors held a video conference call tonight to discuss the best, next steps regarding the education of students. It was determined at tonight's meeting to indefinitely delay the return to school beyond April 1. The school board is meeting weekly and we will keep you notified of any changes & updates in a timely manner. Responding to the COVID-19 pandemic is a fluid situation and we are not able to give a specific return date at this time.

That being said, we want to focus on what we are able to do. First, we petition you to pray fervently for God's blessings and protection over our country, state, county, city and school. God hears our prayers! Second, we are beginning to solidify our remote learning plan so all students, preschool to high school, are engaged by April 6.

We will communicate with you early next week with specific details regarding book and/or curriculum pick up, assignments, etc. You will personally hear from your child's teacher(s) as well. Trust that we will implement remote learning plans that put students, parents and teachers in a place of success. It is neither our desire nor our intent to overwhelm you. We are here to support you in ensuring your student continues to learn, grow and be challenged!

The school board voted to extend the enrollment fee discount (\$50 off for PreK and \$100 off for K-12) through May 31. Also, from this point forward, billing of enrollment fees for the 2020-21 school year will be delayed until May 31 as well. While we work our way through these "uncharted waters," we must continue to work together, living out our 'One School, One Team, One Family' motto. We understand times of uncertainty can be unsettling. Thankfully, our hope & trust is in the Lord and He will never fail us.
